# **Scripture**

Psalm 23; Matthew 25: 1-13 (NRSV)

## Psalm 23: A Psalm of David.

<sup>1</sup> The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside still waters;<sup>[a]</sup> he restores my soul.<sup>[b]</sup> He leads me in right paths<sup>[c]</sup> for his name's sake. <sup>4</sup>Even though I walk through the darkest valley,<sup>[d]</sup> I fear no evil; for you are with me; your rod and your staff-<sup>5</sup> You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. <sup>6</sup> Surely<sup>[e]</sup> goodness and mercy<sup>[f]</sup> shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord my whole life long.<sup>[g]</sup>

## Matthew 25: 1-13

"Then the kingdom of heaven will be like this. Ten bridesmaids<sup>[a]</sup> took their lamps and went to meet the bridegroom.<sup>[b] 2</sup> Five of them were foolish, and five were wise. <sup>3</sup> When the foolish took their lamps, they took no oil with them; <sup>4</sup> but the wise took flasks of oil with their lamps. <sup>5</sup> As the bridegroom was delayed, all of them became drowsy and slept. <sup>6</sup> But at midnight there was a shout, 'Look! Here is the bridegroom! Come out to meet him.' <sup>7</sup> Then all those bridesmaids<sup>[C]</sup> got up and trimmed their lamps. <sup>8</sup> The foolish said to the wise, 'Give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.' <sup>9</sup> But the wise replied, 'No! there will not be enough for you and for us; you had better go to the dealers and buy some for yourselves.' <sup>10</sup> And while they went to buy it, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went with him into the wedding banquet; and the door was shut. <sup>11</sup> Later the other bridesmaids<sup>[d]</sup> came also, saying, 'Lord, lord, open to us.' <sup>12</sup> But he replied, 'Truly I tell you, I do not know you.' <sup>13</sup> Keep awake therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour.<sup>[e]</sup>
